## Program Timeline

**IT Support Fellowship** courses are held fully online, with support and additional instruction from ASU faculty.

- Technical Support Fundamentals
- Computer Networking
- Operating Systems and You: Becoming a Power User
- System Administration and IT Infrastructure Services
- IT Security: Defense Against the Digital Dark Arts
- Privacy, Ethics, and Compliance

To apply the skills learned in this program, **IT Support Fellows** will be reviewed by employer partners for an 11+ week part- or full-time paid employment experience. This has the potential to lead to a permanent IT position.

## Program Cost

\$25 registration per course\*, \$400 per course to convert to ASU undergraduate credit.

\*If eligible under AZNext, training may be offered at no cost.

## Admission Requirements

Participants must be:

- 17 years of age or older
- A high school or GED graduate
- Eligible to work in the U.S.
- Interested in a technology career
- Able to commit to part-time or full-time work during or after program completion for hands-on experience
